Training

The Country Management Analyst programme begins before you even join Citigroup. You will be allocated a Buddy who is likely to be a recent Analyst who will be able to give you guidance and answer any questions that you may have before joining. As you progress, a mentorship may be offered in order to steer with career building within our organization.

The rotational programme begins with a dedicated training course. Your formal training, alongside other Analysts, begins with orientation and induction sessions providing an overview of Citigroup and

specifically Citigroup Corporate and Investment Banking. The training, may also include team building, Core Financial Skills, and Presentation Skills, as well as Social Events which will enable you to develop your networking skills.

After the training you will start the rotational programme. At various stages during the programme, Analysts will gather back together for additional training. At the end of the programme, you will receive additional of training, which will cover the enhancement of communication skills and effective relationship building. Once completed you will graduate and move into your new team.
